 Possible work spaces for group activities include the school assembly hall and two outdoor seating areas.







- The activities will be organised and co-ordinated by Rita Calwell, Active Learning Company. Rita will be based in the school for the two days and will need access to the work space at 8.15am-8.30am on Monday 16 August to set up her equipment. The set up would then be in place for the two days and dismantled on Tuesday afternoon at the close of the Summer Scheme.
- In addition, four members of staff from Newmills Primary School will be available each day to provide support. Keith Beattie, Lough Neagh Partnership (LNP), will also be present to accompany each group to the excavation site.
- LNP will provide transport to and from the site.
- Bookings for the Summer Scheme will be administered by Newmills Primary School.
- The Summer Scheme will have places for a total of 40 pupils (or four groups of 5 pupils each day). If possible, the members of each of the four groups of pupils will be decided by Newmills Primary School staff in advance of each day.
- Any photography for newspapers, social media etc. will be requested by parental consent. This will be confirmed by Newmills Primary School.
- Appropriate clothing:
 - Pupils should arrive in their daily footwear. They should also bring a pair of outdoor shoes (e.g. wellington boots) which will be needed for visiting the excavation. As each group returns from the site, outdoor shoes will be taken off and indoor shoes put back on again before re-entering the school.
 - If rain is expected, a waterproof coat is recommended.
 - Pupils will be working with soil and digging and should expect to get their clothes dirty.
- In the event of sunny weather, pupils will be required to bring sun cream and apply it while working on the excavation. A sun hat is also recommended.
- Pupils will need to bring a packed lunch and a snack for breaktime. LNP will also provide some light refreshments and, if possible, some take-home items.
